JPB Leadership Development offers Jewish, Christian, Muslim, Druze, and Alawi youth (9th and 10th graders) the opportunity to advance in influence and change-making through one of our in-school leadership programs. Each program prepares tomorrow's leaders for positive social change and community action. Activities are conducted in English and include: dialogue, conflict resolution and communication skills. Below are our program offerings for the 2022-2023 School Year:

Influencer Program

- 4 sessions, 90 minutes each (in-person)
- Option of 4 weekly meetings, or 2 half-day seminars



Change-Maker Program

- 6 sessions, 90 minutes each (in-person)
- Option of 6 weekly meetings, or 3 halfday seminars

Our *Influencer Program* focuses on providing participants with the opportunities, relationships, and skills they need to become future influencers for peace.



Educational Themes:

Leadership for Peacebuilding

- Understanding personal, collective, and common identities

Our *Change-Maker Program* focuses on providing participants with the opportunities, relationships, and skills they need to become future change-makers for peace.



Educational Themes:

Leadership for Peacebuilding:

- Defining leadership for peacebuilding and identifying the values, skills and practices required to succeed
- Understanding authentic leadership

Identity, Tolerance, & Diversity:

- Understanding our identities as complex, changing over time, and multi-faceted
- Understanding personal, collective, and common identities
- Understanding stereotypes and breaking them down

Communication & Dialogue Skills:

- Understanding the difference between dialogue, discussion, conversation, and debate
- Exploring the importance of communication for developing and maintaining peaceful relationships and stable societies
- Introduction to empathetic/intentional listening

Understanding Conflict:

- Defining and developing examples of conflict, violence, and nonviolence
- Understanding where conflict occurs

Managing & Transforming Conflict:

- Conflict style self-assessment and reflection
- Introduction to spectrum of conflict handling mechanisms to explore various options like mediation, negotiation, and reconciliation.
